### Rules for disposing garbage





























- Please take your garbage to your designated collection site.
  - Please dispose your garbage, following the collection schedule.
- Take your garbage to the designated collection site by 8:30 a.m. on the collection day. The garbage put out on a wrong collection day or after the collection time will be left uncollected.

- Please ensure proper sorting and place garbage in a transparent or semi-transparent plastic bag.
- The garbage without proper sorting will be left uncollected.

### Notice

There is no garbage collection from December 31, 2020 to January 2, 2021 (Plastic containers and packaging will be closed from December 31 to January 3).

### ◆ The garbage you can dispose by taking to the collection site ◆

Types of Garbage	Collection day	Examples of Waste	How to Dispose																										
 <p><b>Plastic containers and packaging</b></p>	Every Thursday	<p>Items with the  logo. Containers and packaging must be fairly clean and dry.</p>       	<p>Transparent or semi-transparent bags must be used.</p> <p>Rinse or wipe off containers and packaging to remove the residue and dirt (dry off after rinsing).</p> <p>If price labels and product labels on containers and packaging don't come off easily, dispose those without peeling off.</p> <p>If items are with dirt not easily coming off or with too much dirt, dispose those items either as burnable waste (soft items) or as non-burnable waste (hard items).</p>																										
 <p><b>Used paper</b></p>	1st Wednesday of every month	   <p>Newspapers (also inserted flyers)</p> <p>Magazines/other paper (note pads, tissue boxes, calendars, Paper bags, copy paper, etc.)</p> <p>Cardboard</p>	<p>Newspapers: Bind with a string or place them in a bag for recycling newspaper.</p> <p>Cardboard: Bind with a string. Do not use bags.</p> <p>Magazines/other papers: Bind with a string or place them in a paper bag/transparent or semi-transparent bag. Remove materials other than paper, such as plastic sheets.</p>																										
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 <p><b>Glass bottles/ Cans/ PET bottles</b></p>	2nd and 4th Monday of every month	    <p>Glass bottles</p> <p>Cans</p> <p>Compressed gas cassettes/spray cans</p> <p>PET bottles</p>	<p>Separate items into glass bottles, PET bottles, cans, and compressed gas cassettes/spray cans. Place them in transparent or semi-transparent bags. Make sure to remove lids from glass bottles and dispose them as non-burnable waste.</p> <p>Rinse off the inside of bottles and cans. Use up the contents of compressed gas cassettes and spray cans, and be sure to pierce them before putting them in a separate bag for disposal.</p>																										
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 <p><b>Burnable waste</b></p>	Every Tuesday and Friday	     <p>Kitchen scraps</p> <p>Tree branches and wood scraps</p> <p>Paper scraps</p> <p>Aluminum foil</p> <p>Rubber/clothing/leather items</p>	<p>Drain kitchen scraps of water fully.</p> <p>Transparent or semi-transparent bags must be used.</p> <p>Futons and carpets must be folded into a bundle no longer than 1m and bound with a string.</p>																										
 <p><b>Non-burnable waste</b></p>	1st and 3rd Monday of every month	   <p>Ceramic/glass/metal items</p> <p>Electric appliances (less than 1m)</p> <p>Plastic items</p>	<p>Transparent or semi-transparent bags must be used.</p> <p>For bottles/cans of oil or paint, make sure contents are not left inside.</p> <p>Batteries must be removed from electric appliances.</p> <p>If the size of an item is more than 1m, it must be disposed as bulky waste.</p>																										
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
