Rules for disposing garbage

- Please take your garbage to your designated collection site.
- Please dispose your garbage, following the collection schedule. Take your garbage to the designated collection site by 8:30 a.m. on the collection day. The garbage put out on a wrong collection day or after the collection time will be left uncollected.

Please ensure proper sorting and place garbage in a transparent or semi-transparent plastic bag.

The garbage without proper sorting will be left uncollected.



There is no garbage collection from December 31, 2020 to January 2, 2021 (Plastic containers and packaging will be closed from December 31 to January 3).

Rinse off the inside of bottles and cans. Use up the contents of compressed gas cassettes and spray cans, and be sure to pierce them before putting them in a separate bag for disposal.

Drain kitchen scraps of water fully. Transparent or semi-transparent bags must be used.

Futons and carpets must be folded into a bundle no longer than 1m and bound with a string.

Electric appliances(less than 1m)



Plastic items

Transparent or semi-transparent bags must be used.

For bottles/cans of oil or paint, make sure contents are not left inside. Batteries must be removed from electric

If the size of an item is more than 1m, it must be disposed as bulky waste.
