Collection Types of **Examples of Waste** How to Dispose Garbage day Transparent or semi-transparent bags must be used. be fairly clean and packaging must be fairly clean and dry. Items with the Rinse or wipe off containers and packaging to remove the residue and dirt (dry off after rinsing). If price labels and product labels on containers and packaging don't come wastes Plastic Egg packages off easily, dispose those without peeling off. Bags for snacks Nets for fruits Containers for foods **Containers** If items are with dirt not easily coming off or with too much dirt, dispose those and items either as burnable waste (soft items) or as Packaging Caps and labels of PET bottle non-burnable waste (hard items). Bottles for cleanser , shampoo Styrene form for all Newspapers: Bind with a string or place them in a bag for recycling newspaper. Cardboard: Bind with a string. Do not use bags. Magazines/other papers: Bind with a string or place them in a paper bag/transparent or semi-transparent bag. Magazines/other paper Newspapers week collection Paper Remove materials other than paper, (note pads, tissue boxes, calendars, Cardboard (also inserted flyers) such as plastic sheets. Paper bags , copy paper, etc.) Waste Separate items into glass bottles, PET Bottles and cans. Place them in transparent or semi-transparent bags. Make sure to remove lids from glass **Glass Bottles/** bottles and dispose them as non-burnable waste. Non- Burnable Waste	For bottles/cans of oil or paint, make sure contents are not left inside. Batteries must be removed from electric appliances. If the size of an item is more than 1m, it must be disposed as bulky waste.
