Rules for disposing garbage

- Please take your garbage to your designated collection site.
- Please dispose your garbage, following the collection schedule.

Take your garbage to the designated collection site by 8:30 a.m. on the collection - Alarm announces the collection date. (Rings either that day or the day before.) day. The garbage put out on a wrong collection day or after the collection time will be left uncollected.

Please ensure proper sorting and place garbage in a transparent or semi-transparent bags.

The garbage without proper sorting will be left uncollected.

- "Sort Out Dictionary" where you can search what category each item belongs to.



- For items without a recycling mark or items that have expanded, please contact the Recycling Promotion Division.





Transparent or semi-transparent bags must be used. Futons and carpets must be folded into a bundle no longer than 1m and bound with a string.

Transparent or semi-transparent bags must be used. For bottles/cans of oil or paint, make sure contents are not left inside. Batteries must be removed from electric appliances. If the size of an item is more than 1m, it must be disposed as bulky waste.
