

### Ishikawa Takuboku, The Tanka Poet of Morioka

Tamayama area is home to Jokoji Temple where Takuboku Ishikawa, the poet best known for his poetry collection titled "Ichiaku no Suna (A Handful of Sand), " was born and Hotokuii Temple, where he later lived. Takuboku strived to become "the best substitute er in Japan," as well as Saito Family's residence where he rented a room sits on the ground of the museum. Kenji Miyazawa was listed as one of the donors in making the Shibutami Park Poem Monument honoring Takuboku. By the way, the time signal chime for Morioka is a music called "Haru Mada Asaku," from a movie about Takuboku.




